Format - general discussion on course unit, distribution of theory, technical and visual-aids in support, case studies, performance-based activity demonstrations, questions, and performance of group activities necessary for understanding the skills and knowledge required for completion of the Unit of Competency Assessment Task.

FINAL ASSESSMENT

Students are deemed competent upon the successful completion of all course Units of Competence and the submission of a home design assignment. Each graduate student shall be certified as competent to perform home interior decor, design, or home start consulting services independently or as an employee.

Upon successful completion of the course, each graduate will be awarded a "Certificate of Attainment" for all Units of Competence completed. Mentoring services will be available for graduates who wish to pursue self-employment.

SIMILAR DESIGN COURSES

Many training and design organizations offer full-time and part-time, on-line interior design and decor courses but many may not be recognised by the building, retail, or design industries. Many of these courses are offered on-line by marketing entrepreneurs promoting and selling costly décor solutions by subterfuge without addressing important design anomalies.

Private training with a highly experienced accredited designer has many advantages. These include the following: -

- \bullet being conversant with up-to-date industry and business practice,
- understanding architectural and interior design historical and current design development,
- having current knowledge of the building materials, fixtures, furnishings and their properties.
- possessing teaching skills to offer custom designed solutions but not excluding flat-pack mass produced off-the-rack products and services.
- legal, compliance issues and standards, and code of conduct and design ethics.

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The Home Interior Decor and Design courses are compiled and written using the National Training Information Service Units of Competence.

Completed Units of Competency may be used for **(RPL)** "Recognition of Prior Learning" when applying to TAFE for further study in Interior Decor and Design.

The School of Interior Decor and Design offers courses in home décor and design, kitchen, bathroom and interior spaces design. These courses prepare students for self-employment or work in retail, wholesale, manufacturing, or building companies, specializing in these areas.

The e-courses minimize course venue contact commitments allowing self-perpetuating study timetables. Contact with the trainer is available via telephone, email, pre-arranged appointments, or Skype.

GENERAL AIMS

Provide graduates with the necessary skills, knowledge, and attitude to enable them to: -

- 3. Develop and recommend new home interior design, kitchen and bathroom design finishing and furnishing proposals.
- 4. Understand colour and colour properties.

- 6. Understand lighting properties and types.
- 7. Design responsible lighting solutions for home enhancement.
- 8. Research, conceptualize and develop industry standard documentation for home interior decorating and design presentation proposals.
- **9.** Research, identify and recommend interior decoration and design finishing materials, fabrics and specialist finishing services.
- 10. Demonstrate basic skills necessary for researching, documenting and administering an interior decorating and design commission through to completion.
- 11. Research architectural styles and their impact on the development of the Australian home.
- **12.** Research and identify basic building elements and identify their impact on home design.
- 13. Research essential building services; and
- **14.** Research and identify design limitations with respect to interior design and decoration.

- The role of a client/employee representative.
- Client expectations of the professional interior decorator and designer.

 schedules, and specifications in support of proposals.
- Preparation of final presentation and visual aids in support of design proposals.
- Understanding cabinetwork construction, manufacture, finishing and design limitations; and
- Essential business practice

The course content and delivery shall comply with all relevant Workplace Standards, Australian Standards Codes, Building Industry and Product Supply Codes relevant to the Building, Design and Retail Industries.
